

Dear Friend of the Steve Rummler HOPE Network,

Drug overdose is the leading cause of accidental death in the United States. A record setting 108,000 fatal overdoses occurred in 2021, and over two-thirds of these involved opioids (CDC). For over a decade, the Steve Rummler HOPE Network has worked tirelessly to prevent overdose deaths; advocate for policies that support improved treatment, recovery, and safety; and build education and awareness on these topics.

Last year, Steve Rummler HOPE Network saw many organization milestones:

- Distributed 17,695 life-saving naloxone kits a 42% increase from 2020.
- Trained 1,904 individuals on how to recognize an opioid overdose and how to administer naloxone to save a life a 73% increase from 2020.
- Established 38 new Naloxone Access Points (NAPs), for a total today of 81. NAPs are publicly accessible pickup sites for naloxone and fentanyl test strips, located all over the state.
- Began distributing fentanyl test strips and distributed 3,328 kits to our Overdose Prevention partners and individuals (that's 13,312 total strips!).

In 2020, there were 3,990 emergency room visits for opioid-involved overdoses (MDH). Every one of these events represents a life saved by proper medical attention and **naloxone**. This is our work and the work of our partners in action. Each naloxone and fentanyl test strip kit we hand out is a chance at recovery. Each health care provider we educate on effective pain management fosters a field more focused on individualized wellness. Each person we educate on Steve's Law is a community member empowered to respond in an overdose crisis.

This year we are proud to present our sixth annual gala: *Resilience*. Our community has made great strides in continued efforts to create solutions to rising overdose rates. We look forward to coming together on **Friday, October 14, 2022** to *honor* the strength of our partners, *inspire* connection in our communities, and *restore* hope for all.


